Legs of die-cast, powder-coated aluminum. Alternatively in white or black lacquer finish with polished sides. Beams of extruded anodized recycled aluminum with transparent or black end caps. Choose from the border to stop 1 cm or 31 cm from the table's short side. Adjustable feet in black or orange acetal.
